## Healing Art Board

Clinic with a Heart was selected to receive a Healing Art Board. The Healing Art Board Project is a special outreach project involving Hildegard Center for the Arts and local artist John Hollingsworth. This arts initiative placed Healing Art Boards at local health and healing

related environments.

Each board is 2' x 4' and has been coated in magnetic paint. Corresponding shapes were cut from thin pieces of wood, painted in bright colors with acrylic paint, and sealed. The backs are given a magnet backing. Our board has casters so it is movable. Each set includes a tray for holding pieces that are not being used. The specifications for the art boards were approved by the Lincoln Lancaster County Health Department.

Madonna Rehabilitation Hospital, Saint Elizabeth Regional Medical Center, and Bryan Health Hospital all committed to purchase one Healing Art Board for their health care sites. Hildegard Center for the Arts agreed to match their purchase with one additional Healing Art Board per hospital to be placed in a non-profit health facility of their choosing.
