#### Is it worth it?

This year, with the help of an army of volunteers, we have gone to approximately 1,000,000 outreach events. OK that is a bit of an exaggeration but it does seem like we're out and about a lot. These events help put us in

contact with people who may need or refer to our services. Those person to person contacts help to build trust and answer questions.

One Saturday in October I had two events to attend. One in a church parking lot and one at Holmes Lake. It was one of those wet cold days. I was wondering at the second event "is this all worth it?" Isn't it funny how when you ask a question like that, the answer walks right over to you? It wasn't one answer but several.

First, a woman came up to me when she saw our table and told me her brother had come to see us. She told me that we found cancer in him. With a donation of diagnostics tests from Advanced Medical Imaging, the cancer was found early. We referred the patient to a program run by the Lancaster County Medical Society to get him to a specialist. They got him in quickly and his prognosis is good.

Next, a young woman came up to the table and said she was walking and heard her knee "crunch" and was in terrible pain. She was planning on coming to the Thursday clinic to see a medical provider and a physical therapist. She was so thankful to have a place to turn. She described her circumstances a little -- a young professional who had been laid off from her job and who no longer had insurance. She was getting by, but just barely. She found out about

the clinic at her church, one of our mission team sponsors.

Is this worth it? That day I got a big YES! At Clinic with a Heart we don't usually get to hear the front-end or the back-end of the story but that day I got to hear both. I heard what a difference it makes to have a place to turn to. I also heard that Clinic with a Heart could not help people without strong partners and collaborators.
